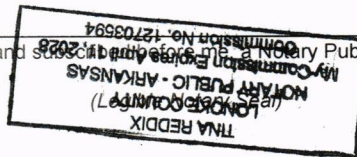

IMPORTANT

The limits on campaign contributions do not apply to loans or contributions made by a candidate from his or her own personal funds to the campaign or to personal loans made by financial institutions to the candidate and applied to his or her campaign.
